Dibrugarh University, the easternmost University was set up in 1965 under the provisions of the Dibrugarh University Act, 1965 enacted by the Assam Legislative Assembly. The University is also a member of the Association of Common Wealth Universities. The University is situated in Rajab-heta at a distance of about five kilometers to the south of the premier town of Dibrugarh.



The University introduced the MCA course in its Centre for Computer Studies in January 2007 with the same course being conducted in its affiliated institutes Jorhat Engineering College and North Eastern Regional Institute of Management, Guwahati with due approval from the AICTE.

Eligibility for Admission



MCA :- Graduate in any discipline with a minimum aggregate of 50% in Bachelor's degree examination and passing mathematics as one of the subjects in 10+2 or degree level examination. Relaxation will be as per Govt. rules. Students appearing in the Bachelor's degree final examination whose results have not yet been declared can also apply.

BCA :- Candidates who have passed 10+2/Higher Secondary examination or equivalent with a minimum aggregate of 45% and Mathematics/Statistics/Commercial Arithmetic as one of the passed subjects.

Method of Selection

MCA :- The admission into the MCA course is made through a Common Admission Test conducted by Dibrugarh University. The CAT will be conducted at the following centres :-

1. Centre for Computer Studies, Dibrugarh University
2. NERIM, Guwahati
3. J.B. College, Jorhat

BCA :- The admission to the BCA course will be on merit basis.

Pattern of Question Paper for CAT(MCA)

100 questions of multiple choice type on Mathematics (10+2 level), general aptitude and general English.

The duration of the CAT shall be of two hours.
